Survey of Prince George's County Council Candidate

July 29, 2010

1. Inclusionary Zoning

Many county and municipal jurisdictions use Inclusionary Zoning as a way to build and renew housing for their low-income and moderate income residents. Do you support or oppose some form of legislation that would require developers to include moderate and low-income housing units in future housing developments?

2. Housing Trust Fund

The State of Maryland and neighboring jurisdictions have Housing Trust Funds. Do you oppose or support the creation of a Prince George's County Affordable Housing Trust Fund for the acquisition, construction, rehabilitation, or preservation of affordable housing and then the allocation of funds for this trust?

3. Housing Fairness

In several areas of the County, residential property owners refuse to rent to families whose incomes derive from such government assistance as federal housing vouchers, Social Security payments, or welfare grants. The measure would allow landlords to screen applicants based on rental history and other relevant factors. Do you support or oppose legislation prohibiting discrimination in housing based on the applicant's source of income.

4. Envision Prince George's

Envision Prince George's is an initiative of the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC). It has engaged individuals and groups from across the County as active participants and stakeholders in envisioning the County's future. Do you support or oppose the implementation of the Envision process in all of its multiple areas of concern?

5. Domestic Violence Shelter

The availability of temporary and extended housing for victims of domestic violence and their children is scarce and limited in Prince George's County. Do you support or oppose funding for additional shelter for victims of domestic violence?

6. Domestic Violence Monitoring

In May 2010, Governor O'Malley signed several bills passed by the General Assembly to assist domestic violence victims. Among them is House Bill 665 which sets up a pilot program here in Prince George's County that would allow judges to release individuals before their trial for violations of protective orders on the condition that they are wearing a global positioning satellite tracking device. Do you support or oppose funding this program?

7. Student Transportation

On August 20, 2009, Prince George's County officially withdrew from the Kids Ride Free program with the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority. The Prince George's County Board of Education has decided to reduce the number of school bus drivers in the 2011 Budget, which could mean students may face longer rides or may need to take two buses. Do you support or oppose the restoration of the Kids Ride Free Program with the WMATA?

8. Community Benefit Agreements

A Community Benefit Agreement is a legally binding agreement between the developer and community organizations to create additional community services or facilities for the neighborhood being developed. Do you support or oppose the creation of Community Benefit Agreements as part of the development process in Prince George's County?
